**Hill Fontaine** (Following the 72 Arrow Tournament and Lunch)

Barebow Sudden 'Death' Following the 72 Arrow Round after Field is Reset. Barebow Archers will start at 5 meters and shoot at elevated plastic balls. Archers who hit will move on, archers who miss are eliminated. Archers will move back in 5 Meter increments until only one archer successfully hits a ball to earn victory.

**Arrow Chucking** (Following Hill Fontaine-on the lower portion of the hill adjacent to clubhouse)

Archers will get three attempts to throw an arrow as far as they possibly can. The archer who throws their arrow the furthest will win.

**Clout Round** (Following Arrow Chucking-This event will occur on the opposite side of the club property, buggies/cart transportation will be available to transfer shooters, or they may drive)

Clout Flag and Ring will be set 165 meters from the shooting line. Six ends of six arrows will be shot by every archer participating. The goal is to get arrows closest to the center pin.
