Rules: Main Rifle Range

- 1. ABSOLUTELY NO FIREARM HANDLING while anyone is beyond the firing line.
- 2. Eye and Ear protection are mandatory for ANYONE in the range, including spectators and children.
- 3. Anyone going down range should turn their switch on. The RED LIGHTS will flash until all switches are turned off. (Make sure to check with all shooters BEFORE turning the switch on).
- 4. All firearms are preferred to be cased or holstered (NO Cross Draw) when entering and leaving the range. If not cased, all actions must be open and unloaded and no ammunition in the firearm. (Does not apply to a protection gun you are not firing on the range)
 - 4a. Does not apply to a protection gun on the range
- 5. The ONLY targets allowed are paper targets.
- 6. All Firearm Discharges must be downrange between the orange target cross board supports. No targets are to be attached to the main poles.
- 7. Prospective Member policy: See posted signs.
- 8. Violations of the range rules: MEMBERS WILL BE FINANCIALLY LIABLE for damages incurred.
- 9. This is your club, as a member you are part owner, maintain and police as your own.
- 10. The following calibers are **not** allowed on the range:
 - .50 BMG
- 11. NO FULL AUTO ALLOWED
- 12. When going downrange, past the firing line, all shooters must agree the range is cold
- 13. When ready to fire, all shooters must agree the range is hot
- 14. Members must display their membership badge and guests must display guest pass

Definitions:

- Cold Range: All firearms must have open actions, unloaded, no ammo in chamber, magazine detached and step away from the firearm
- Hot Range: All shooters are back behind the firing line and all shooters confirm they are ready to shoot.
